**TUESDAY JUNE 2: SALAMANCA**

**WEDNESDAY JUNE 3: SALAMANCA**

This morning, enjoy a guided city walk through the heart of Salamanca, a city renowned for its golden sandstone architecture and rich academic heritage. In the evening, reconvene with your fellow musicians for a rehearsal, as you prepare for your first concert performance of your tour this evening, as part of an exchange with a local ensemble!

**THURSDAY JUNE 4: SALAMANCA**

Today depart for the walled city of Ávila, home of St. Theresa of Avila and renowned for its remarkably preserved Medieval Walls that date back to the 11th century. Enjoy a guided tour, taking in the breathtaking views of this UNESCO World Heritage site. Continue to Segovia where you'll visit the

Alcázar of Segovia, a fortress that inspired Disney's Cinderella Castle. Return to Salamanca where this evening you'll have time for dinner on your own. (B)

### **FRIDAY JUNE 5: SALAMANCA**

After breakfast, enjoy an excursion to the historic city of Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that boasts a rich blend of Christian, Jewish, and Muslim cultural influences. Known for its stunning medieval architecture, Toledo offers a captivating glimpse into Spain's past. Enjoy a guided city walk through the winding streets, taking in the grandeur of Toledo Cathedral, the Alcázar, and the charming Jewish Quarter. This afternoon, board the bus for a trip to Valladolid, where we will rehearse with the Gospel Choir there for a joint concert this evening. Dinner in Valladolid and return to Salamanca after the concert. (B)

### **SATURDAY JUNE 6: BURGOS**

Today you'll depart for the celebrated Ribera del Duero wine region, one of Spain's premier viticultural areas. Surrounded by rolling vineyards and historic villages, you'll enjoy a guided visit to a traditional wine cellar, where you'll learn about the region's winemaking heritage and sample some of its acclaimed vintages. A group lunch is included today. Later, check into your hotel in Burgos and have dinner on your own. (B,L) Hotel: Silken Gran Teatro

### **DAY 7, SUNDAY JUNE 7: BURGOS**

This morning, participate in mass in the UNESCO-listed Burgos Cathedral, a masterpiece of Gothic design and the final resting place of the legendary El Cid. After lunch, embark on a guided exploration of Burgos, a city renowned for its stunning Gothic architecture and rich historical significance. (B)

### **DAY 8, MONDAY JUNE 8: SAN SEBASTIAN**

Depart in the morning for the dynamic city of Bilbao, the beating heart of the Basque Country. Known for its blend of cutting-edge design and rich industrial past, Bilbao offers a perfect balance of old and new. Discover the city's highlights, including a visit to the world-famous Guggenheim Museum.

Designed by architect Frank Gehry, this architectural marvel houses an impressive collection of contemporary and modern art and is an icon of Bilbao's transformation. In the afternoon, continue your journey through the Basque landscape to the picturesque coastal city of San Sebastián. With its stunning beaches, Belle Époque charm, and culinary reputation, San Sebastián is a true gem. After checking into your hotel, the evening is yours to relax and soak in the seaside atmosphere. ### **DAY 9, TUESDAY JUNE 9: SAN SEBASTIAN**

Discover the coastal elegance of San Sebastián at your own pace. Perhaps take time to explore the city's charming Old Town, walk along the sparkling shores of La Concha Bay, or simply relax and take in the stunning scenery. You'll have free time for lunch, perfect for sampling the region's world-famous pintxos and fresh Basque specialties. In the afternoon, regroup and prepare for your third concert performance of the tour, taking place in the San Sebastián area in conjunction with a local ensemble. (B)

### **DAY 10, WEDNESDAY JUNE 10: SAN SEBASTIAN**

After breakfast, depart for Hondarribia, a charming Basque town near the French border. Take some time to explore the quaint streets and enjoy the local atmosphere as you enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, continue your journey to Biarritz, a beautiful French seaside town known for its stunning beaches and vibrant cultural scene. Explore the city's highlights, including the Biarritz Lighthouse and the iconic Rocher de la Vierge rock formation. (B)

### **DAY 11, THURSDAY JUNE 11: MADRID**

Depart San Sebastián and travel to the legendary city of Pamplona, renowned for the world-famous Running of the Bulls. ## **DAY 13, SATURDAY JUNE 13: DEPARTURE**

Transfer to the airport for return flight to the United States. (B)

**The group leader is Laurie Schreiner and our tour number is 270006.**

Guaranteed price (regardless of airfare or hotel cost increases) includes all gratuities and emergency medical coverage. Additional “cancel for any reason” trip insurance is available for \$715 (\$815 for those 66 and older). A \$100 discount is given to those who sign up for autopay and the additional trip insurance. There is no surcharge for paying by credit card.

- \$200 deposit is due June 15. If you cancel before November 30, 2025 and haven't taken out the “cancel for any reason” trip insurance, you would lose your deposit, but all other payments would be refunded.
- Payments are due August 15, October 15, and final payment is due January 15, 2026 – unless you opt for autopay, which will take out a set amount each month from your bank account or credit card. Then your final payment is due April 14, 2026.
- If you fly with the group, the airline assigns the seats, but we will work out seat assignments among our group to meet mobility concerns and to seat partners/friends together. The tour company can work with you on alternate departures and returns, but cannot do one-way flights. They will honor your Global Entry, TSA precheck, and frequent

flyer numbers and can upgrade your flight to Premium Economy or Business Class upon request.

- Single supplement is \$1320 (hotels are expensive!).
- A limited number of triple rooms are available. There is no price discount for triple rooms.
